# **INTRODUCTION**

The Royce Hub Building in Manchester offers a range of high-quality meeting spaces which are open to the national materials research and innovation community.

Venue hire at the Royce Hub Building is at no cost for materials networking, research, industry and technology focused events or meetings. We can support your Events Manager with additional services such as catering, A/V support and evening receptions.

Our meeting rooms each provide hybrid technology solutions for events with a basic AV set up which is suitable for most standard meetings. Enhanced media packages and expert support is available for an additional cost where required.

# **ABOUT THE VENUE**

The design of the nine storey Royce Hub Building was driven by a vision to engage scientists, industry and the public by showcasing the Institute's work and providing a flexible environment for world-class research.

The building sits at the heart of the University of Manchester's science and engineering campus, and represents an initial investment of £105 million by the Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council (EPSRC). It hosts over £45 million of brand-new state-of-the-art equipment.

The ground floor entrance is overlooked by a mezzanine and offers views into material testing spaces. Terraced floors provide visitors with glimpses into workspaces as they climb the distinctive staircase through a stepped, three-storey atrium. These atria house local collaboration hubs with lounge seating and views out across The University of Manchester's campus and the city beyond.

The building was officially opened in 2021 by Professor Dame Ottoline Leyser, CEO of UK Research and Innovation (UKRI).

The Royce Hub Building is only able to accommodate events and meetings which are related to materials research and innovation.

As a condition of our EPSRC funding and as a free-to-access venue, we are also unable to accommodate sales activities or paid-for ticketed events within the venue.



# **OUR SPACES**

The Royce Hub Building offers a range of meeting rooms and event spaces designed to support Advanced Materials Research and Innovation. These high specification spaces provide bright, open environments and are suitable for a range of different events including conferences, awards ceremonies, networking events and receptions.





### THE FOYER

A dynamic and bright event space, perfect for receptions, networking events, informal presentations and poster displays.

This modern, open, multipurpose event space is characterised by large windows and the building's distinctive staircase, creating a lively and airy ambiance. The Foyer can accommodate a variety of layouts and is a popular location for evening receptions, large talks, networking events and awards ceremonies.

#### THE MEZZANINE

Characterised by an open plan, and surrounded by large windows which constitute the building's façade, this event space is the perfect choice for dining, receptions and formal events.

The flexible layout of the Mezzanine makes a great choice for networking sessions and conference breaks. It can also be used for hosting lunches or tea breaks between meetings in the seminar or meeting rooms.

#### **COMBINED SEMINAR ROOM**

A large and versatile presentation space, perfect for conferences, meetings or seminars.

Located on the first floor of the Royce Hub Building, this room is our largest meeting space, and consists of Seminar Room A (1.014) and Seminar Room B (1.015) conjoined. The room can be arranged in a variety of layouts and is popular for conferences, seminars, large meetings and talks. The rooms feature a removal partition and can be booked a single rooms or one large space.





# TRANSPORT AND PARKING

There is a paid APCOA car park (Car Park Aquatics Centre, Booth Street East, Manchester, M13 9SS) located directly next to the Royce Hub Building. Please see the university website for details regarding other campus car parks. Blue Badge holders should please contact us if they would like to request a free parking space near the building.

There are two car parks on campus with charging bays for electric vehicles. These are located at the Booth Street West car park (5 minute walk from Royce; 4 spaces on the ground floor and 4 spaces on the first floor) and at the Cecil Street car park (15 minute walk from Royce; 4 spaces). These spaces are allocated on a first come, first served basis.

There are multiple bus stops near the building.
The nearest bus stops are located on Upper Brook
Street and at the University Shopping Centre on the
Oxford Road. The stop on Upper Brook Street is
served by routes 50 and 53 orbits. At the University
Shopping Centre, the stop is served by routes 15, 18,
41, 43, 53 orbits, 111, 142, 143, 147, V1, V2 and V4.
There are multiple other bus stops along and adjacent
to Oxford Road only a brief walk away from Royce.

The Royce Hub Building is well served by Oxford Road and Piccadilly train stations, both a 15-minute walk away. Victoria is also accessible at a 30-minute walk, or a 15-minute car/taxi journey.

The nearest tram stops are Piccadilly and St Peter's Square, both a 20-minute walk away.

There are standard bike stands located in front of the building, as well as a large two-tier covered bike shelter. These are cycle lanes and paths throughout the university campus.
